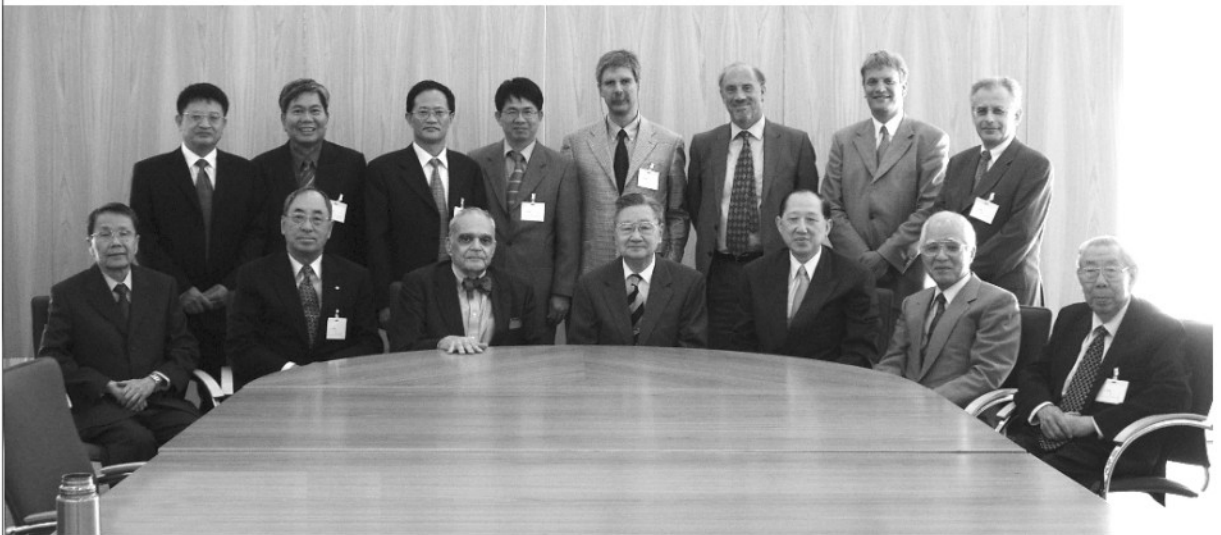

**Prof. Rüdiger WOLFRUM**

*Prof. Wolfrum is Co-Director of Max Planck Institute of International and Comparative Law in Heidelberg, Germany, Professor of Faculty of Law, University of Heidelberg, and Honorary Professor of Faculty of Law, University of Hamburg. He was Professor of Chair of National Public and International Public Law and Director, Institute of International Law, University of Kiel; Vice-Rector, University of Kiel; Judge at the Courts of Appeal for Administrative Matters, Lüneburg and Schleswig. He joined the UN Tribunal for the Law of the Sea in October 1996 and served as President of the Tribunal during 2005 and 2008.*



**Prof. Nicholas MICHEL**

*Prof. Michel has been a member of the Institute faculty since 2008, and is also a Full Professor on the Faculty of Law at the University of Geneva. He has previously been the Under-Secretary-General for Legal Affairs and United Nations Legal Counsel from 2004 to 2008. From 1998 to 2003, he acted as the Director of the International Law Directorate in the Swiss Federal Department of Foreign Affairs, and served from 1998 to 2004 as Legal Adviser in the same Department. Professor Michel was Professor of International Law and European Law at the University of Fribourg, Switzerland, from 1987 to 2004.*

**Prof. Nicolas Jan SCHRIJVER**

*Prof. Schrijver is Professor of Public International Law, Leiden University; President of the Netherlands Society of International Law; Member of the Royal Netherlands Academy of Arts and Sciences; Member of the Permanent Court of Arbitration; and Member of the UN Committee on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights. He appeared before the International Court of Justice and the International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea, and as legal counsel in law of the sea cases before special ad hoc tribunals.*



**Prof. Gurdip SINGH**

*Prof. Singh is Professor of Law and Head and Dean of Faculty of Law at Delhi University, India. He has been serving at the Faculty of Law, Delhi University ever since 1977, teaching international law and environmental law. He has published five books and 55 articles in leading national and international legal journals.*

**Prof. Charles H. NORCHI**

*Prof. Norchi is Associate Professor of Law and Director of the Marine Law Institute. He teaches Public International Law, Marine Law and Comparative Law as well as advanced seminars in those fields. He has consulted in more than two dozen countries, primarily on behalf of International Organizations and United Nations agencies.*



**Prof. Wenhua SHAN**

*Prof. Shan is Professor of International Law at Oxford Brookes University, England, and Tengfei Professor of Law and the Dean of the School of Law at Xi'an Jiaotong University, China. He is also Vice-President of the Chinese Society of European Law and has been the Founding President of the UK Chinese Law Association (UKCLA).*



**Prof. Robert McCORQUODALE**

*Prof. McCorquodale became the Director of the British Institute of International and Comparative Law in January 2008. He is Professor of International Law and Human Rights, and former Head (Dean) of the School of Law, at the University of Nottingham. Previously he was a Fellow and Lecturer in Law at St. John's College, University of Cambridge and then at the Australian National University in Canberra.*



**Prof. Margaret Hsu-Chi WANG**

*Prof. Wang is Professor of International Law, Soochow University School of Law. For several years she was in charge of legal affairs of WTO. She got her first degree from Soochow Law School, LL.M. from Boston University law School, and Ph.D. from Beijing University. Her specialties include International Law, International Economic & Financial Law, and Business Law.*



# Admission

## General Information

1. The closing date of the application for admission is 30 April 2011.
2. Applicants to the Xiamen Academy should be:
  - (1) law students; or
  - (2) teachers, lawyers or officials, etc. with at least a bachelor degree; and
  - (3) fluent in English.
3. The admission office of Xiamen Academy retains the right to require applicants to supply related documents or certificates to show their qualification or competency.
4. Admissions are granted on a basis of academic criteria and first-come-first-served basis. All applicants are required to fill out the registration form (downloadable from the Academy's website) clearly and completely, with accurate and truthful information.

## Other Information

1. Visa Application: All fees necessary for acquiring China entry visas shall be payable by the applicants. However, the Xiamen Academy may provide any necessary assistance to the applicants to facilitate their visa application.
2. If applicant would like to apply for scholarship, please make clear the type of scholarship you intend to apply in the application documents.
3. Participants are responsible for their accommodation in Xiamen. If possible, Xiamen Academy will provide necessary assistance.
4. If there is anything unclear, please feel free to contact us.

## Application Documents Checklist

Checklist of the application documents:

1. A registration form;
2. A letter of recommendation from a professor of international law (in a sealed envelope, signed on the reverse);
3. A curriculum vitae;
4. A certified copy of your examination certificates or list of the courses that you have followed in international law (private and public), with the number of hours and your results, issued by your university. If this is not possible, draw up by yourself and certify on your honour; and
5. An application for scholarship and supporting documents, if applicable.



## Registration Fee

### Registration fee for 2011 Summer Program (3 weeks)

For Chinese Mainland applicants:

- (1) University Students: RMB 1,000;
- (2) University Teachers: RMB 2,000; and
- (3) Others: RMB 3,000.

For Non-Chinese Mainland applicants, including applicants from Hong Kong, Macau and Chinese Taipei: USD 600.

*\* Please note that the registration fee covers test fee and course materials, but does not cover any other expenses including but not limited to accommodation, transport, etc.*

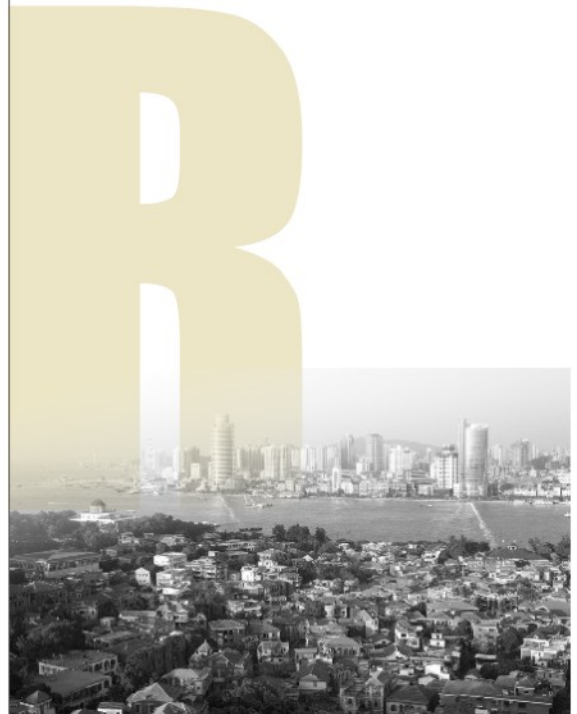

# Scholarship



## Types and Eligibility for Scholarships

1. Subject to the Regulations for Obtaining Scholarships, Xiamen Academy provides limited number of scholarships to qualified applicants (both Chinese Mainland and Non-Chinese Mainland) on a selective basis.
2. Xiamen Academy offers two types of scholarships:
  - 2.1. A-type scholarship includes:
    - (1) Full exemption of the registration fee;
    - (2) A certain sum of subsidy for the trip to and from participant's city to Xiamen:
      - a. US\$ 400 for Asian participants (excluding Chinese Mainland participants), or
      - b. US\$ 600 for non-Asian participants, or
      - c. Full reimbursement to round-trip hard-seat train tickets for Chinese Mainland participants.
  - 2.2. B-type scholarship includes full exemption of the registration fee.
3. The scholarships will be payable to participants during the period of summer program. However, failure to finish the program or unexcused absenteeism from the course will result in the forfeiture of the scholarship in full, requiring a full refund of the scholarship by the disqualified participant.
4. Scholarships are granted on the considerations of academic performance, financial status of applicants and the types of country of origin, among other factors.
5. Application for scholarship shall be submitted in a separate typewritten document indicating the type of scholarship, together with supporting documents.





# Scholarship Regulations

## Regulations for Obtaining Scholarships

### Article 1

*Each year, Xiamen Academy makes available a programme of scholarships which are awarded on the considerations of academic performance, financial status and the types of country of origin, among other factors.*

### Article 2

*Recipients of scholarship must undertake to comply strictly with the provisions of these regulations concerning their obligations, in the event their application is accepted by the Curatorium. None of the documents supplied by candidates in support of a scholarship application will be returned. As a result, university certificates must be provided in the form of certified copies.*

### Article 3

*Application for scholarship must be typewritten and accompanied by supporting documents, and must be received by the Secretariat, by post only, not later than 30 April 2011.*

### Article 4

*The Curatorium examines all applications received before the deadline. It establishes a list of the recipients of scholarship; and it is in no way bound by any recommendation that it receives.*

### Article 5

*The Curatorium's decisions will be notified to the persons concerned during the month of May.*



### Article 6

*The amount of the scholarship is paid by the Academy to each recipient during the period of summer program.*

### Article 7

*Recipients of scholarship must attend the Academy's courses throughout the session.*

### Article 8

*Any failure by a scholarship recipient to comply with the obligations laid down by these regulations will result in the withdrawal of the scholarship; moreover, the Academy reserves the right to demand the reimbursement of sums already paid to the recipient.*
